SPECIAL NOTE HERE:

REMEMBER: HIGH FREQUENCY WORDS ARE MORE DIFFICULT FOR THOSE WITH A HEARING LOSS TO UNDERSTAND.

Remember: Presented here are high and low frequency test words. They can be used for unaided and aided discrimination testing.

What you will find is, that the hearing impaired's unaided discrimination will be poor in any environment.

When unaided sound field testing is performed in a sound proof room, that unaided score using those high frequency words will be low.

The master-aided score, using those high frequency words will show marked improvement, only when you use a correctly selected per-octave rise and gain coefficient, with that master aid.

Always present the same type of words in your evaluations, when demonstrating your discrimination comparisons.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Always use the appropriate words required by your state regulating agency if necessary.
